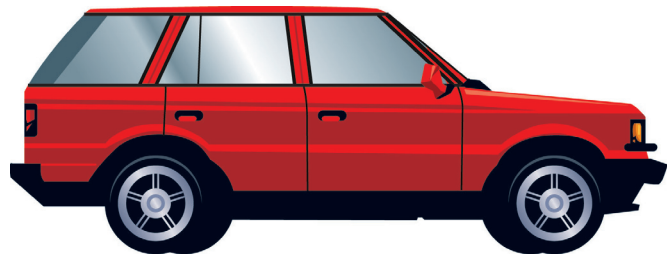


36 Reasons To Love Meade County, Kentucky

We have one of the lowest crime rates in Kentucky.



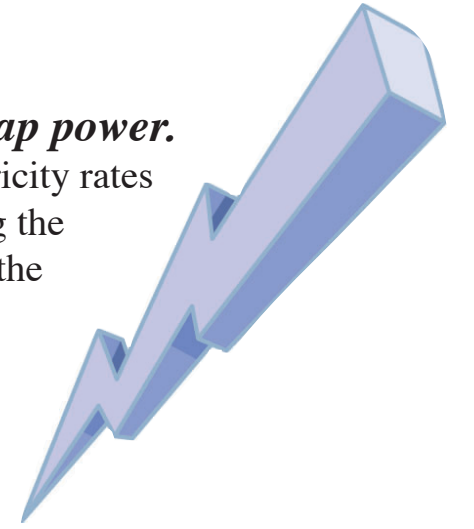
5. The Meade Activity Center.

Nature puts on a great show each fall.

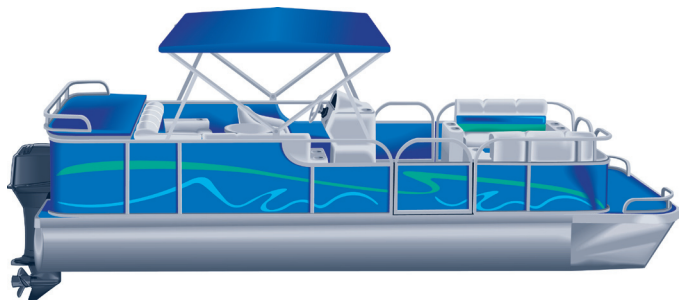
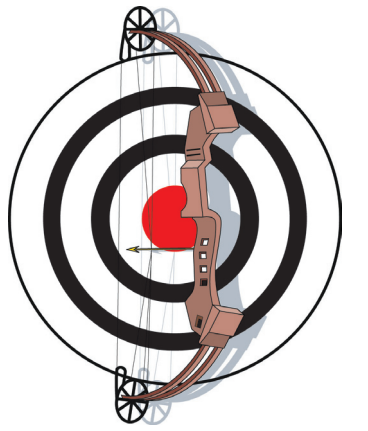


14. Meade County Public Library.

Meade County has a vibrant faith community.



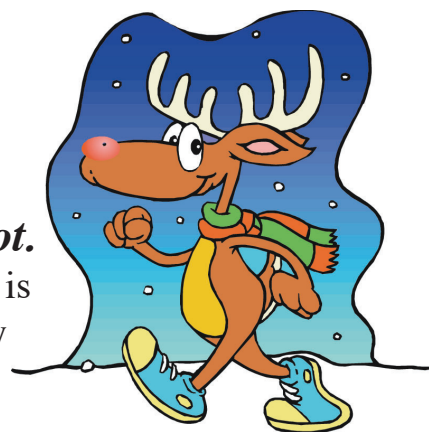
26. High per capita income. Our county is high in the state's rankings.
